DIVISION OF REVENUE & TAXATION

The Division of Revenue & Taxation (DRT) provides taxpayers assistance in understanding & meeting their tax responsibilities, while enforcing the law.

DRT issued approximately \$22.5 million to over twenty-seven thousand (27,000) taxpayers via Visa Debit Card during the second round of the local stimulus. DRT kicked off their Revenue Management Information System project with the full implementation targeted for 2024. A total of 3,350 & 3,051 customer tickets were opened and closed, respectively, under *Jitbit* Customer Service ticketing system to track calls and taxpayer issues.
